Vinification	Prunier owns 3 parcels of 40-45yo vines totalling 0.5Ha, all with perfect south east exposure and planted on friable, thin and rocky soils. The vineyard sits right beside a major Volnay 1er cru. 20% new oak is used, with the yield averaging 42hl/ha in 2022.
