### Monthelie rouge 2023, Domaine Prunier-Bonheur

This may not be the most renowned of appellations but it is here where the value can be found ! Produced from 45 year old vines planted on clay limestone soils and facing due west, with a breathtaking view of the Auxey-Duresses valley. 'Un Petit Volnay' as Pascal Prunier Bonheur says!! What a beautifully constructed wine.

#### Tasting Notes:

A delicious compote of ripe, concentrated black fruits, the palate is oozing richness, laden with cassis fruits with a muscly core. The tannins are ripe and yielding but give ample support and the finish continues in a vein of richness and happiness !
