Château Batailley, a historic 5th growth estate, is one of the jewels of the Castéja family and the Borie-Manoux firm. It is a consistent producer of Cabernet Sauvignon dominant claret with firm structure and excellent ageing potential.

### Tasting Notes:

A deep and intense black fruit bouquet with notes of fresh tobacco. This is a sturdy Batailley, rich in compact cassis fruits with a super blueberry freshness and notes of red cherry. The cedar oak is very much in check, there is some spice and alluring notes of lavender boosted by a layer of forest floor. The finish is long a brooding - an excellent Pauillac!
