One of the world's great red wines Bin 707 is a full-bodied red wine produced from Cabernet Sauvignon grapes in South Australia and is the perfect Cabernet Sauvignon representation of Penfolds 'House Style': intensely flavoured fruit; completion of fermentation and maturation in new oak. Not produced in every vintage.

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#### Tasting Notes:

"Rather seductive aromas of cedar and bark with blackberries, blackcurrants, light milk chocolate and stone. Full-bodied, very round and polished. Tight, focused tannins at the end. Ink and baking spices. Finished fermentation in American oak and aged 18 months. Try after 2027" James Suckling 97 points

Launched with the 1964 vintage but not made from 1970 to 1975 (when fruit was directed to other wines) nor in 1981, 1995, 2000, 2003, 2011, 2017 or 2020 (when fruit of the required style and quality was not available). 'Unashamedly 100% Cabernet, 100% new oak, 100% Penfolds', they say. Glowing dark purple. Intensely aromatic. Smooth, ripe-tannined cassis liqueur. Limpid. Long. With marked spicy sweetness before those tannins come galloping in. Definitely for the long haul." Jancis Robinson
