This vineyard is situated next to Chevalier Montrachet and is planted with 40 year old vines. As usual this is an impressive wine offering both elegance and power with a tight steely backbone and gunflint minerality. With only 4 barrels produced this wine is a Grand Cru in all but name.

By Allen Meadows, Burghound, Oct-15, Issue #60 "Subtle but not invisible wood serves as a relatively neutral backdrop for the wonderfully elegant, cool and pure nose that features notes of acacia blossom, citrus, apple and essence of pear scents. The sense of refinement continues on the mineral-inflected medium-bodied flavors that possess even better depth and gorgeously long finish. This is a really lovely effort where the natural class of a great Puligny is very much on display. (Drink starting 2020) 94 points
