A 2/3 hectare plot purchased a number of years ago from Louis Chavy, this wine always provides excellent value for money and punches way above its price tag. Due to poor flowering and mildew, Alban produced just 50% of the usual yield, only 35 hl/ha.

#### Tasting Notes:

The nose is clean and mineral driven with pure aromas of white peach and wet stone. On the palate, the wine is fresh and vibrant with notes of honeysuckle and tropical fruit with excellent concentration balanced by a crisp, lively acidity.
