Produced from a blend of red indigenous Douro grapes, this full-bodied red wine is elegant and sophisticated with flavours of ripe fruit, jam and spice. This is a Reserva that combines power and finesse, and reveals all the character of the Douro grape varieties as well as having excellent gastronomic and aging potential.

### Tasting Notes:

An intense, almost opaque ruby colour, revealing concentration and depth. On the nose, beautiful notes of ripe berries and forest fruits stand out, accompanied by nuances of dark cherries, liquorice, and subtle white pepper. On the palate it is full-bodied, yet balanced, with a silky texture supported by good acidity and ripe, polished tannins. The structure is refined, harmonious, and profoundly flavourful, lingering in a persistent, and very elegant finish.
