This south-west facing, single plot of vines was planted in 1990 on a steep slope to the east of the village of Saint-Romain towards Auxey-Duresses. The soil is predominantly white marl and limestone with some clay. A tight fruit structure and quenching salinity, providing a Chablis-esque character to the wine.

Tasting Notes:

This is a fantastic white Burgundy, with a rich, ripe and expansive palate of ripe peach, dessert apple and honey, with an edge of sweet oak. An appellation that is very much on the up.
