This is a monopole of the Domaine Tollot-Beaut estate, part of the Fournot 1er cru, covering 1ha and was planted in 1954. It produces the most structured wine of the two Savigny-lès-Beaune premier cru appellations. It is situated just below the Les Lavières vineyard and benefits from a sunnier exposure. With more clay in its soils, this wine is always laden with ripe red and black cherry, liquorice and espresso characters.

Tasting Notes:

Aged in 25% new oak, this is a rich, ripe and joyful expression of Pinot Noir. Rich, almost smoky at first with deep dark colour, tremendously sweet cherry fruit, a hint of caramel from the oak and intense spice and fresh acidity. A wonderful taut, yet generous red that will keep 10-20 years
