This is a monopole of the Domaine Tollot-Beaut estate, covering 1 hectare and was planted in 1954. It produces the most structured wine of the two Savigny-lès-Beaune premier cru appellations. It is situated just below the Les Lavières vineyard and benefits from a sunnier exposure. With more clay in its soils, this wine is always laden with ripe red and black cherry, liquorice and espresso characters.

Tasting Notes:

This richly textured Pinot is always a favourite amongst true Burgundy fans. A big, structured wine, showing exotic lush and sweet red and black fruits, menthol, liquorice, chocolate, ginger and vanilla, it has ripe tannins and a lovely balancing freshness and an almost earthy sweet finish.
