Tasting Notes:

Very fragrant, open and lush, with red and black fruits, opening on the palate to a seductive, textural mouth-feel. This wine is complex, medium weight and elegant, offering touches of pomegranate, raspberry and finely laced tannins.

The family has a lovely spread of top vineyards in Savigny-les-Beaune (both superb premier crus and a handful of top village wine parcels planted with very old pinot noir vines), as well as a bit of premier cru in Beaune and Pommard as well. |
