Owned by the Brunier family for over a century, this is the second wine of Vieux Télégraphe, produced from younger vines (under 30 years old) or older vines grown outside the famed Plateaux of La Crau and Piedlong. This is a classic Télégramme – perfect to enjoy now while you wait for “La Crau” to age.

Tasting Notes:

Fruit driven and expressive, the nose reveals opulent damson, plum and cassis. On the palate, rich prunes with a full, mouth-coating texture, complemented by silky tannins and a supple, elegant structure.
