Sourced from a single parcel of 55-year-old vines on the stony Plateau de la Crau. Rich and complex with a touch of oak and notes of apricot and honeysuckle with a striking minerality with a long saline finish. Produced in limited quantities—this is a rarity you can't afford to miss!

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### Tasting Notes:

The nose is expressive, with lemon zest, honeysuckle, acacia, and dried apricot. On the palate, it's rich yet refined with flavours of ripe peach, citrus, and toasted hazelnut and a striking minerality with a long saline finish. A wine of elegance and balance, combining creaming texture with vibrant freshness, it promises excellent evolution in the bottle.
