This is an enjoyable light, refreshing wine. Found exclusively in western France, Folle Blanche is a rare white grape that was once ubiquitous across the region. This variety is perhaps best known for its distillation into brandy, especially in the Cognac and Armagnac regions. Folle Blanche is also used in Pays Nantais, in the west of the Loire Valley, where it is known as Gros Plant and used in the production of dry white wines.

Tasting Notes:

Yellow in colour with green tinges. A light, balanced, refreshing wine with notes of green apple and lime and mineral notes.
