A classic, almost Cote d'Or in style this is a bargain with a capital B! Produced from 3ha of vineyards split into four separate parcels planted in 1922, 1932, 1949 and 1951 that average 60 years of age.

Tasting Notes:

Beautiful viscosity and succulent ripe fruits. There are layers of buttered apple and pear, melon and almond nut, with minerality and a highly appealing lime acidity. Spice, clove and buttered apple finish the wine nicely.
